Specialty Care Coordination across County Departments

DHS, DPH, DMH, Jails and Juvenile Court Collaboration

The County of Los Angeles has many departments that interact with county residents who have health concerns. In seeking to effectively address these needs, the **Department of Public Health (DPH)** the **Department of Mental Health (DMH)**, the **Sherriff's Department Medical Services Bureau (Jails)**, the **Juvenile Court Health System (JCHS)** and the **Department of Health Services (DHS)** have invested in coordinating with each other through participation in our Specialty Primary Care (SPC) Workgroups and in eConsult.

This collaboration has resulted in making county specialty care services readily available to those who need them. A few highlights of these efforts are below:


- On October 9th, 2015, the Mental Health SPC
 Workgroup with membership from both DMH and
 DHS providers launched a Mental Health portal for
 adult patients on eConsult. This portal will provide
 prompt access to Mental Health experts and, if
 needed, coordinated scheduling to providers in DMH
 Network clinics.
- Via a Tuberculosis Control Program eConsult portal, DPH offers expert advice to medical providers in need of assistance with their patients who have tuberculosis infection and active tuberculosis disease.
- Clinicians working in clinics in the Jails, Juvenile
 Detention Halls and DPH facilities are all able to
 access specialty expertise and coordinate care via
 eConsult. In the last 12 months alone, over 1,600
 patients have been served through this connection.

With the Board of Supervisors approval of the Health Agency, we expect there will be more such opportunities for patient-centric coordination of care.
